The ICERS Cell O/o the Director General, Highways, Government of Tamil Nadu an implementing agency of the Employer, now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for conducting Road Condition Survey using Advanced Data Collection Equipment for a length of 23,468 km across State highways and Major District Roads (MDR). The Service Provider shall complete the road survey and update data in the Road Maintenance Management System (RMMS) within a period of 12 months from the date of signing of contract.
- 3. Bidding will be conducted through National Competitive Bidding procedures agreed with the World Bank. Bidding is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the World Bank's Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers, January 2011 revised July 2014. Bidders from India should, however, be registered with the Government of Tamil Nadu or other State Governments/ Government of India, or State/ Central Government Undertakings. Bidders from India, who are not registered as above, on the date of bidding, can also participate provided they get themselves registered by the time of contract signing, if they become successful bidders.

- 5. The bidding document is available online on <u>https://tntenders.gov.in</u> (website) from 07.09.2020 to 14.10.2020. The bidder would be responsible for ensuring that any addenda available on the website is also downloaded and incorporated.
- 6. For submission of the bid, the bidder is required to have Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) from one of the Certifying Authorities authorised by Government of India for issuing DSC.
- 7. Bids must be submitted online on *https://tntenders.gov.in*(website) on or before 15.00 hours on 14.10.2020 and will be opened online on the same day at 15.30 hours. bid or modifications to bid (including discount) received outside e-procurement system will not be considered. If the office happens to be closed on the date of opening of the bids as specified, the bids will be opened on the next working day at the same time and venue. The electronic bidding system would not allow any late submission of bids.
- 8. All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security declaration as per the format given.
- 9. The bidders are required to scan and upload (a) bid security declaration in approved form; and (b) affidavit regarding correctness of information furnished with bid document *(insert name and complete address)* in the e-procurement portal.
